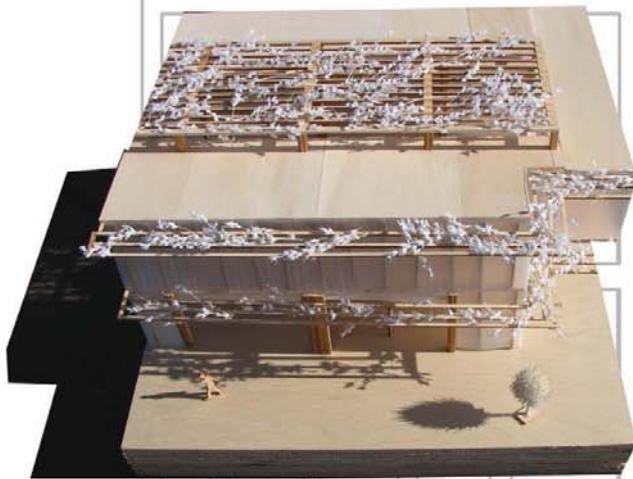


SHADING
