Underground multipurpose area intended primarily as a stage for the performing arts. One descends into the space and the stage is a sunken in the center of this gathering space. Above, at ground level, is a reinforced glass ceiling/glass floor with approximately 4-inches of water. During the summer, this is intended as a reflection pool and play/splash pool. Once the temperature cools off in the winter, this pool turns into an ice-skating rink.


